Each year, the Space Coast Jazz Society awards scholarships to graduating Brevard County high school seniors who are registered for continuing education. Applicants must be interested in furthering their studies in jazz music, but do not need to major in music.

The scholarship money is sent directly to the school of continuing education. Scholarships are valid from the time of the award through the fall semester of the following year (i.e. awarded Spring 2026, available through Fall 2027). If the student has not used the scholarship within that time period, the money will be returned to the Space Coast Jazz Society's education fund. SUPPORTING MATERIALS

(items 1-3 can be submitted as one document).

1. A paragraph describing your past musical accomplishments and studies.
2. A paragraph on your college plans and how they would be aided by a cash award.
3. A brief essay of how you became interested in jazz, with comments on 3 musical figures who inspired you.
4. A statement from **2 references** with a brief commentary about your talent, character, and seriousness of intent.
5. A short **audio or video of you performing SOLO** (YouTube links are acceptable). It does not have to be professional quality, but does need to be audible.
